

Model an Enumeration using the Class notation in Rose.
 Mark the classes that represent enumerations with the "Enumeration" Stereotype.
 Use the class' description to document the enumeration's usage.

Use class' Attributes to denote Enumerators.
 Use the attribute's name to specify the enumerator's literal value.
 Use the attribute's description to document the enumerator's usage.
 Use the attribute's initial value to specify the enumerator's numeric value.
 Specify the enumerator's numeric value only if it is out of order of enumerators.

A name of an enumeration shall end with "Type", like ConcurrencyType.
 The enumeration value name shall be in upper case and prefixed with the enumeration name (without Type), like CONCURRENCY_SEQUENTIAL.

Some (old) enumeration do not use the enumeration name in the name of its members. You should mark them with Stereotype "EnumerationN" for now.
